## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding ('MOU') is entered on this date of 21-03-2023  
By and between **KING EDWARD MEDICAL UNIVERSITY, LAHORE (KEMU)**, represented herein by Vice Chancellor (KEMU), Prof. Mahmood Ayyaz AND **THE SHAHID JAVED BURKI INSTITUTE OF PUBLIC POLICY at NetSol (BIPP)**, having head office at Lahore represented herein by its Vice Chairman, Mr. Shahid Najam, hereinafter jointly referred to as the "Parties".

**WHEREAS**, King Edward Medical University will be a renowned national and world class academia maintaining a leading role in medical education, innovative research and provision of best health care services of international standards. King Edward Medical University will prepare clinicians and allied health professionals in accordance with highest professional standards to practice evidence based medicine maintaining international quality of patient-centered care in the health care delivery system and will produce research scholars demonstrating excellence in knowledge, skills, and empathetic values empowered with community oriented self-directed learning and professional development.

**WHEREAS**, BIPP is an independent non-profit institution aiming at: promoting rights and evidence based inclusive policy making in economic, social, environmental, security and foreign policy related issues in Pakistan; filling the institutional void; professionalizing the key policy areas; producing and inculcating leaders and leadership traits; and serving as a knowledge hub for leadership and policy analysis, development and implementation.

**WHEREAS**, BIPP and KEMU are interested to cooperate in the areas of mutual interest relating to policy dialogues, education learning and joint research and consultancy.

### **Article I**

#### **Purpose**

The purpose of this MOU is to provide a framework of cooperation between the Parties, in the areas of mutual interest on a non-exclusive basis especially relating to education, research & consultancy, and developing/running a mechanism for BIPP scholarship program.

### **Article II**

#### **Areas of Cooperation**

The Parties agree to cooperate in the following areas of activity

##### **2.1 Scholarships**

BIPP will offer 9 scholarships to the students of KEMU in the programs of BS Allied Health Sciences and BS Vision Sciences on need cum merit base where income of the family of the student should not exceed Rs. 70,000/= per month. Scholarships will be offered from Fall 2022 admission for the bachelor program. Students must have to score 60% marks in each professional year to continue to receive the scholarship. Students must have to maintain a 3 GPA to receive the scholarship.

##### **2.2 Seminars and Conferences**

- Facilitating and organizing seminars, thematic discussions and conferences jointly on issues of mutual interest;
- Providing guest speakers, moderators etc., for the seminars and workshops.

## 2.3 Think Tank

- Providing experts and resource persons for the Think Tank related activities especially on issues of regional and global significance as mutually agreed;

### Article III

#### Consultation and Exchange of Information

- 3.1 The Parties shall, on a regular basis, keep each other informed of and consult on matters of common interest, which in their opinion are likely to lead to mutual collaboration;
- 3.2 Consultation and exchange of information and documents under this Article shall be without prejudice to arrangements, which may be required to safeguard the confidential and restricted character of certain information and documents.
- 3.3 The Parties shall, at such intervals as deemed appropriate, convene meetings to review the progress of activities being carried out under the present MOU and to plan future activities;
- 3.4 The Parties may invite each other to send observers or participants to meetings or conferences convened by them or under their auspices in which, in the opinion of either party, the other may have an interest. Invitations shall be subject to the procedures applicable to such meetings or conferences

### Article IV

#### Implementation of the MOU

- 4.1 The implementation of this MOU will be facilitated as follows:

- 4.1.1 The Parties agree that all decision making will be purely on merit and based on best business practices and acumen;
- 4.1.2 Each party shall designate one or more focal persons for the purpose of effective functioning, communication and deliberation with each other for achieving the purposes of this MOU. Such focal persons shall communicate frequently and will try to provide timely response to each other.

- 4.2 The Parties will make available their respective platforms and expertise in the pursuit of the conduct of their activities as specifically agreed;
- 4.3 Neither Party shall be an agent, representative or joint partner of the other Party. Neither Party shall enter into any contract or commitment on behalf of the other Party and shall be solely responsible for making all payments to and on behalf of its own account, as provided under this MOU and under cost-sharing agreements concluded hereunder

#### **Article V**

##### **Use of Name and Emblem**

- 5.1 Neither Party shall use the name, emblem or trademarks of the other party, or any of its subsidiaries, and/or affiliates, or any abbreviation thereof, without the express prior written approval of the other Party in each case;
- 5.2 The Parties agree to recognize and acknowledge this partnership, as appropriate. To this end, the Parties shall consult with each other concerning the manner and form of such recognition and acknowledgement

#### **Article VI**

##### **Term, Termination, Amendment**

- 6.1 The proposed cooperation under this MOU is non-exclusive and shall have duration of an initial period of three years commencing on the effective date of entry into operation. It can, however, be terminated earlier by either party upon three months' notice in writing to the other party. The Parties may agree to extend this MOU in writing for subsequent periods of two years;
- 6.2 In the event of termination of the MOU, any cooperation arrangement concluded pursuant to this MOU, may also be terminated in accordance with the termination provision contained in such agreements. In such case, the Parties shall take the necessary steps to ensure that the activities carried out under the MOU, are brought to a prompt and orderly conclusion;
- 6.3 This MOU may be amended only by mutual written agreement of the Parties

#### **Article VII**

##### **Notices and Addresses**

Any notice or request required or permitted to be given or made under this MOU shall be in writing. Such notice or request shall be deemed to have been duly given or made when it shall have been delivered by hand, certified mail, overnight courier, telex, or cable to the party to which it is required to be given or made at the address specified below or such other address as shall be hereafter notified.

#### **Article VIII**

##### **Settlement of Disputes**

- 8.1 The Parties shall use their best efforts to settle amicably any dispute, controversy or claim arising out of this MOU.
- 8.2 Any dispute, controversy or claim between the Parties arising out of this MOU which is not settled amicably in accordance with the foregoing paragraph shall be referred to arbitration.
- 8.3 Failure by either Party to enforce a provision of this MOU shall not constitute a waiver of that or any other provision of this MOU. The invalidity or unenforceability of any provision of this MOU shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of the MOU.


**Article IX**
